I was always reluctant to change out all my coolant tanks and move to a different coolant. This is not an easy task when you have several machines and the process of changing out coolant requires you to shut down and clean the tank. You could lose production and valuable man hours. However, I'd recommend it to anyone who ever had a conversation or headache about coolant. This is not something we should be concerned with or hassle about when there are so many other things in our shop that require our attention.

After several discussions with my MDM rep and continuous badgering I agreed to do so and this completely changed my opinion of "coolant is coolant." I am 100% pleased with everything about this product. The employees are happy because it doesn't stain their hands or leave a terrible smell in the machine. I'm happy with the way it separates from the oil allowing me to use the coolant more often without cleaning the tank or constantly adding to the consistency. I have also noticed that we have been able to speed up production mainly because my machinist isn't dealing with foam or sludge as was the case with other products. I cut carbon steel and stainless metals all day and the semi synthetic 737 is perfect for what we do. The price is right and I've never had an issue with delivery or getting a rep to contact me concerning questions.

All this is great and they tell me I'm also REACH compliant which matters to my customers and the environment so that's cool. I wouldn't recommend this product specifically but I would recommend not worrying about or dealing with issues concerning coolant and that's exactly what Hangsterfer has done for me.
